A getaway in the south of France

For a trip like this, there's no better means of transport than a well-equipped van that can take you effortlessly from Bayonne to Nice. With four berths, a kitchen and a convenient bathroom, a road trip with family or friends is a piece of cake! Our journey starts with some of the most picturesque beaches the Basque country has to offer: Bayonne, the famous Rocher de la Vierge in Biarritz, and Saint-Jean-de-Luz. Next, head for the Pyrénées Orientales. For those of you who are partial to a mountain hike, make sure you spend a night at Bouillouses Lake, the starting point for the ascent up Pic Carlit.

After this high altitude detour, head to the fortified city of Carcassonne, located just a few hours away: there's nothing like a medieval citadel to bring you back to your senses! After wine-tasting in the Minervois, immerse yourself in the trance-like sounds of the cicadas and the unpretentious charm of the towns in the south before heading to Montpellier. Continue your journey with stops at the calanques of Marseille, the Cévennes National Park, the Mediterranean coast and finally... Nice, which is home to the Colline du Château and the Matisse Museum, not to mention rugged cliffs and sandy beaches, which are different yet no less spectacular than the ones at the beginning of your journey.

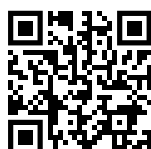

Road trip in Norway



Are you struggling to find somewhere with incredible scenery for your next family holiday? Why not explore Norway in a converted van? Travel with unfettered freedom, cross fjords, and enjoy mountain hikes (the country boasts almost 300 peaks over 2000m): Norway is guaranteed to take your breath away. From remarkable attractions to enchanting landscapes, you will be spoilt for choice. The fjord region, starting at Bergen, is simply spectacular. Make sure you take your fill of fresh air at Hardangervidda national park, too. If you're seeking a more urban atmosphere, be sure to visit Oslo, the capital, and also Ålesund, an Art Nouveau town not far from the Runde bird sanctuary. Explore Switzerland in a converted van!

In Geneva, soak up the breathtaking views of the lake of the same name, which also happens to be the largest in Western Europe.

If you like mountain hikes, Switzerland will not disappoint: the Dents du Midi, the Peak Walk bridge, the Col de la Forclaz and the Susten Pass are just some of the peaks that offer one of a kind panoramic views.

Many lakes are also worth a visit, such as Lake Emosson and Lake Oeschinen in the Interlaken region, whose silvery blue waters are mesmerisingly beautiful. Your trip to Switzerland wouldn't be complete without a visit to Gruyère, the charming village that gave its name to the famous cheese, and whose grandiose castle dominates the skyline. To round off your trip, plan a stopover at Lake Lucerne before exploring the Piumogna waterfall in the south of the country not far from Italy.

Your visit to Switzerland by van will vary dramatically depending on whether you visit in winter (best for skiing and mountaineering enthusiasts) or in summer (best for hiking). It's important that your van can transport you around Switzerland with ease, whatever the season or temperature!

A weekend tour of the Auvergne



This year, why not head for the Auvergne? For lovers of nature and jaw-dropping scenery, the Auvergne will not fail to impress. Sports enthusiasts and experienced (or novice!) hikers are also well catered for: whether you're holidaying as a couple, with family or friends, in fine weather, or in the winter, make the most of the fresh air!

The Massif Central is well-known for its puys and volcanoes. This is why we suggest starting your journey among the volcanoes of the

Auvergne by climbing the most famous peaks in the region: Puy-de-Dôme and Puy de Sancy.

If you'd prefer a more leisurely walk on flat ground or gently undulating terrain after conquering the imposing Puys, why not try the Cézaillier hike or the Queuille meander? You'll find a number of quaint villages dotted along your route, including Le Puy-en-Velay, Salers, Royat, home to the oldest oak tree in France (250 years old!), Aurillac, and Polignac with its majestic fortress.

Life in a van: adventurer mode activated!

Any self-respecting hiker should travel in a specially adapted and fully equipped vehicle. A 2 or 3 berth Randger 4x4 van is the ideal travel companion. Perfectly insulated, it will help keep you warm or cool as the seasons change.

Your converted van will take you anywhere, in any weather, all the way down to the foothills of the Auvergne mountains.
